NON-RECYCLABLE REFUSE ITEMS

Prepaid Refuse Stickers

Residents may purchase prepaid refuse stickers at City Hall, the Woodstock Library, Jewel Foods, or Wisteds in Woodstock. Each bag of refuse placed curbside must have a prepaid sticker attached. Bags should not exceed 50 lbs.

Tote Service

We also provide 95-gallon tote service. The service is billed on a quarterly basis. Please call MDC office at (815) 334-0014 to arrange for this service. All trash must fit inside the tote with lid closed. Anything outside of tote (other than recycling) is an additional charge and will not be collected unless a prepaid refuse sticker is attached to the bag or prior arrangements are made with MDC.

RECYCLING

We recycle on the same day as your refuse pickup. We will collect an unlimited amount of recyclable items for no additional charge. Recycling bins are available for purchase by Woodstock City residents at City Hall. Please call City Hall at (815) 338-4300 for information.



Items that MDC recycles at curbside:

- Newspaper and inserts
- Chipboard (i.e. cereal boxes, pop cases)
- Magazines, Catalogs, Telephone Books
- Office Paper, Junk Mail, School Paper
- Paper Grocery Bags
- Corrugated Cardboard
(Must be cut down into 2 ft by 2 ft squares and bundled)
- Plastic Items
(Coded 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7)
- Glass Bottles & Jars
(Clear, Green & Brown)
- Aluminum & Tin Cans

All types of papers, chipboard, corrugated should be wax free.

Kindly have your refuse and recyclables at the curb by 6:00 AM on the day of pickup.

YARD WASTE

The City of Woodstock has instituted a curbside yard waste pickup program. Yard waste may be placed in 30-gallon biodegradable brown paper bags, bundles* or in open 30-gallon maximum garbage cans. Yard waste in plastic bags cannot be picked up. Each bag, bundle or can must be affixed with a yard waste sticker. These stickers are available for purchase at all of the locations listed above, and are also available at the City of Woodstock Public Works Center.

*Bundled tree branches must be no longer than 4 feet in length and no larger in diameter than a 30-gallon garbage can.

HOLIDAYS

MDC observes the following legal holidays: New Years Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. If your collection day is on or after one of these holidays, your collection will be one day later for that week only.

New Program for City of Woodstock Residents - Bulk Items

A bulk item is any single item too large to fit into a bag or a 95 gallon tote. Each bulk item must have two (2) prepaid refuse stickers attached in order to be collected.

“White Goods” such as refrigerators, stoves, etc. are not considered bulk items. You must call MDC to make arrangement for the collection of white goods.
